







Plant Database – Ornamental Grasses

Grasses by Common Name

| Common Name | Scientific Name | Comments |
|---|---------------------------------------|--|
| <p>Blue Fescue</p>  | Festuca ovina 'Glauca' | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Small (8 to 10"), clump forming grass • Full sun • Selections for improved blue color; 'Elijah Blue', 'Boulder Blue' • May also be listed as <i>Festuca cinerea</i> |
| <p>Fountaingrass</p>  | Pennisetum alopecuroides | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Low (18 to 24"), clump forming grass • Cultivars: 'Hameln', 'Moudry' |
| <p>Japanese Bloodgrass</p>  | Imperata cylindrica 'Red Baron' | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Size: 15 to 18" • Leaves red in full sun • Spreads by rhizomes to form patch |
| <p>Maiden Grass</p>  | Miscanthus sinensis | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Medium sized (4 to 5'), clump forming grass • Cultivars: 'Gracillimus', 'Zebrinus', 'Strictus' |
| <p>Ornamental Sedge</p>  | Carex sp. | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Usually a low (12"), clump forming grass • Many species and cultivars (mainly for variegated leaves) • Full sun |
